Like every other complex and difficult art, the art of teaching can be acquired only through careful training and the conscious application of underlying principles. The consciousness of these facts has given rise in all culture countries to schools maintained at public cost for the purpose of giving young men and women preparing for teaching such instruction in principles, methods, and devices, and such practice in their application as will enable them to begin the work of teaching with some degree of certainty of success. In this country such schools are called normal schools. Although the United States has done less for the preparation of its teachers than other countries in proportion to expenditures for education and to numbers of children in school, there are in this country 235 State normal schools, with a total attendance of about 89,537 students and an...
